

WE'RE RECRUITING!

Researchers at the University of Louisville Kent School of Social Work and Family Science are conducting a research study to learn about the relationship and health needs of adults with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities by interviewing them and their care providers (paid or family).

We're recruiting pairs of care recipients and care providers. You may be eligible for this research study if you are over 18 and have an intellectual/developmental disability *and* have a care provider who is with you for more than twenty hours per week and is also willing to be interviewed.

Study participants will receive information about healthy relationships and will be eligible to participate in future interventions based on the results of the study.
